Small Business Assistance

The U.S. Small Business Administration designated the State of Ohio eligible for Economic Injury Disaster Loans due to the COVID-19 outbreak. Any small business or nonprofit affected directly or indirectly can apply for up to \$2 million in low interest loans through the SBA. These loans may be used to pay fixed debts, payroll, accounts payable and other bills that cannot be paid because of the disaster's impact.
